(President: Morimasa Matsuda, "DEI") has acquired 49% equity interest in a utility-scale battery energy storage project in Land Sachsen-Anhalt, Germany (13.8 MW). The project has been developed by Second Foundation, who will remain the majority shareholder and the commercial operator.

The project has been developed to further promote the adoption of renewable energy and enhance the stability of the power grid. It has finished its operational testing and is scheduled to begin full commercial operations within 2025. The project is planned to operate for over 15 years, generating revenue through participation in the power market and ancillary services.

Through participation in this project, DEI will contribute to addressing environmental issues such as the promotion of renewable energy generation and thus prevention of CO2 emissions. We will continue to actively invest in promising renewable energy and battery storage projects both in Japan and overseas.
